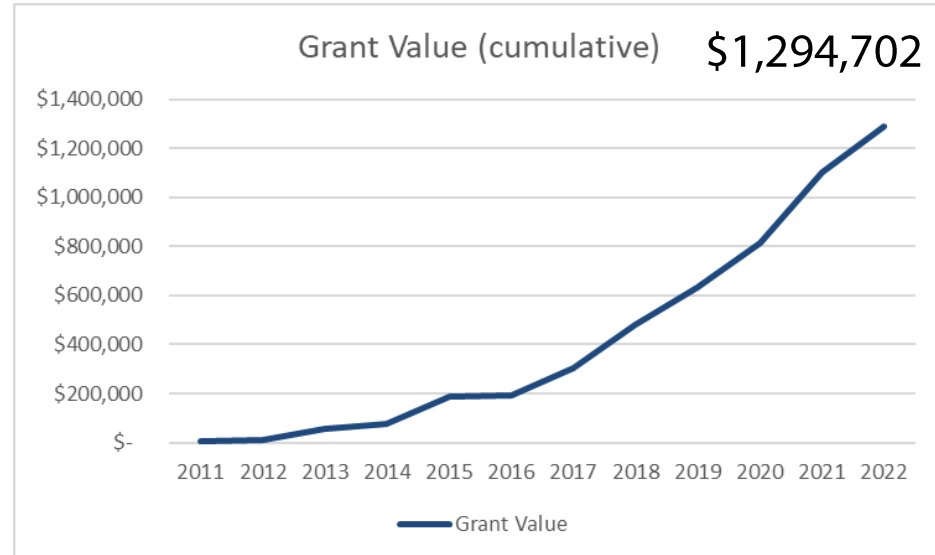

The Palm Springs Police Department received funding for K9 Finley, an emotional support animal for the benefit and wellness of their officers. PSPD lost two officers in 2016 and their loss is still deeply felt. K9 Finley lives and works at the police department, available to officers and staff around the clock. The grant was sponsored by the Renee & Gordon Graham Foundation, who helped to present the grant, valued at \$3,500.

The Puerto Rico Police Department received 550 C-A-T Tourniquets (North American Rescue) and an equal number of Tourniquet NOW! pouches (Blue Force Gear). Additionally, they received 138 custom trauma kits (North American Rescue). The grant was sponsored by Walmart Puerto Rico and Blue Force Gear, who donated their product. The grant was the second largest ever awarded, valued at \$50,226.

Forward Looking - 2023



- The Foundation will explore new partnerships to enable a dedicated In Car Computer grant program. This will allow the Foundation to assist smaller agencies to get access to this technology and information.
- The Foundation has conducted research and drafted a legislative recommendation to the members of the Puerto Rico State Senate for the issuance and funding for tourniquets for all police officers throughout the territory. As this progresses, Spirit of Blue will pursue a third grant for trauma equipment to the Puerto Rico Police Department.
- The Foundation will grant a minimum of 1,000 tourniquets and 350 Guardian Angel personal lighting devices as part of initiatives to see these items become standard issue for officers' uniforms nationwide going forward.
- We are still on plan to grant another \$1,000,000 in equipment and training by the end of 2026 – twice as fast as our first \$1,000,000 in grants completed in 2021!
